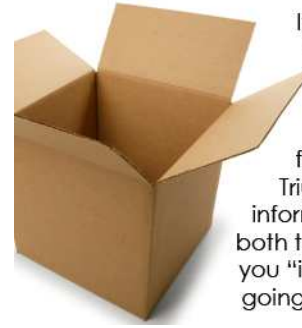

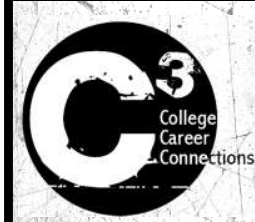
Sunday School Kids Sing January 31st
