## Church Facility Use...Let Us Help

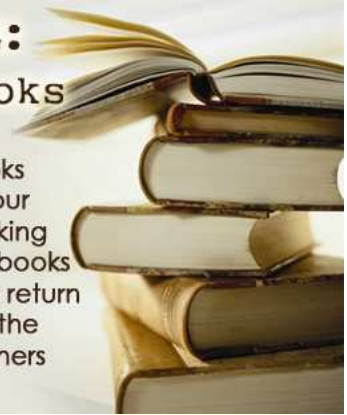
