## “Jesus the Redeemer in 3-C”

Luke 7:36-50 (NIV)

### 1-C: The Contrast of \_\_\_\_\_ with the Redeemer

<sup>36</sup>Now **one of the Pharisees** [Simon] invited **Jesus** to have dinner with him, so **he** went to the **Pharisee's house** and reclined at the table. <sup>37</sup>When **a woman** who had lived a sinful life in that town learned that **Jesus** was eating at the **Pharisee's** house, **she** brought an alabaster jar of perfume, <sup>38</sup>and as **she** stood behind **him** at **his** feet weeping, **she** began to wet **his** feet with **her** tears. Then **she** wiped them with **her** hair, kissed **them** and poured perfume on **them**. <sup>39</sup>When **the Pharisee** who had invited **him** saw this, **he** said to **himself**, "If **this man** were a prophet, **he** would know **who** is touching **him** and what kind of **woman she** is—that **she** is a sinner."

### 2-C: The Cancellation of \_\_\_\_\_ by the Redeemer

<sup>40</sup>Jesus answered him, "Simon, I have something to tell you." "Tell me, teacher," he said. <sup>41</sup>"Two men owed money to a certain money-lender. One owed him five hundred [silver coins] and the other fifty. <sup>42</sup>Neither of them had the money to pay him back, so he canceled the debts of both. Now which of them will love him more?" <sup>43</sup>Simon replied, "I suppose the one who had the bigger debt canceled." "You have judged correctly," Jesus said.

### 3-C: The Case of \_\_\_\_\_ Because of the Redeemer

<sup>44</sup>Then he turned toward the woman and said to Simon, "**Do you see this woman?** I came into your house. You did not give me any water for my feet, but she wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. <sup>45</sup>You did not give me a kiss, but this woman, from the time I entered, has not stopped kissing my feet. <sup>46</sup>You did not put oil on my head, but she has poured perfume on my feet. <sup>47</sup>Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—for she loved much. But he who has been forgiven little loves little." <sup>48</sup>Then Jesus said to her, "**Your sins are forgiven.**" <sup>49</sup>The other guests began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" <sup>50</sup>Jesus said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; **go in\* peace.**"
